Since its launch in 2007, the Vélomagg' public bike system (57 stations and 370 bikes), is operated by TAM (Transports de l'agglomération de Montpellier)



Since January 2020, TAM is using Qucit Bike to improve its operations to optimize its service (**improved availability**) while absorbing new rentals!

Gains in availability have led to more seamless service for Vélomagg users, who are becoming increasingly supportive of bike-sharing.
